Kantolomba Compound is a desperately impoverished slum in one of the poorest countries in the world.

When we arrived there:

- Unemployment was close to 100%.
- Houses ranged from cardboard shacks with plastic roofs to mud huts with tin roofs.
- There was no running water or electricity. Sewage flows through the dirt streets.
- Children played in the sewage. There was no medical care. Disease was rampant.
- Everyone was hungry. People did not have enough money to provide adequate food for their family.
- There was one community school, but few children attended. They were too hungry or sick to make the journey and to do schoolwork.

Living Compassion is:

- Feeding and educating over 350 of the most vulnerable children in Kantolomba and expanding the program.
- Providing clean water from the first well in Kantolomba
- Providing medical care at the first clinic with a doctor
- Providing safe housing through the roof loan program
- Employing and mentoring adults through the sewing cooperative and the men's cooperative
- Providing a center for community involvement with the Community Center complex
- Establishing micro-finance projects and helping community members to find their own income sources
- Moving closer to the goal of feeding ALL hungry children in Kantolomba
